community action partnership of riverside county - rental unit through the federally funded low-income home energy assistance program (liheap). eligibility for this program is based on the household's total monthly gross income (see attached guidelines). because of significant funding cuts, the federal government requires us to follow priority ratings.

energy services programs low-income weatherization ... - currently, there are three federally funded programs: low income home energy assistance program (liheap), us department of energy weatherization assistance program (doe-wap), and the bonneville power administration (bpa). public purpose charge funds the energy conservation helping oregonians (echo) program.
